



Here's what happens...

David has done something really, really bad, and someone points it out to him. David realizes the weight of his sin and cries out to God, asking God to give him a new heart, to clean him, and to restore his joy. David knows that when he asks God for forgiveness, he is forgiven.

Bible Point:

We are forgiven.

"And the very hairs on your head are all numbered. So don't be afraid; you are more valuable to God than a whole flock of sparrows" (Luke 12:7).

Family Together Time

- Count how many sinks are in your house.
- Work as a family to make a sign to hang above each sink.
- The signs should say "You are forgiven" and can also be decorated however your family members would like.
- It's also great to include Psalm 51:7: "Purify me from my sins, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow."
- Hang the signs above your sinks so that every time you wash your hands, it will be a reminder that God cleans away your sins, too.
