



Here's what happens...

As he prepares to head to the cross, Jesus has one last meal with his friends. Before the meal, Jesus does the job normally reserved for servants: He washes his friends' feet. Jesus does this to set an example and show that we are God's servants.

Bible Point:

We are God's servants.

"And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns" (Philippians 1:6).

Through the Week

- As a family, everyone will say a chore they wish someone else would do for them. (Parents, think of things your kids could do or at least help you with.)
- Everyone will trade chores for the week, choosing one of the chores someone named and doing it to serve the person who normally does it. For example, maybe the person who normally takes out the trash will do the dishes this week, and the person who cleans the bathrooms will take out the trash, freeing up the person who does the dishes to clean the bathrooms.
- As you do each other's chores, pray for the person you're serving by doing the chore.
