



### Here's what happens...

Jesus tells his friends that he's like a vine and we are the branches. On their own, branches can't grow any fruit. But when they're attached to the vine, they can grow a lot of fruit! In the same way, when we're attached to Jesus, we grow the fruit of love.

### Bible Point:

We are growing in God.

*"And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns" (Philippians 1:6).*

### Family Together Time

- If your family has a growth chart (such as notches in a doorway), gather there. Mark everyone's height. (Even the grown-ups!)
- If you have a child who brought home a Growth Chart craft, feel free to use that instead.
- If you don't have a growth chart, use sticky notes, painter's tape, or another removable item to mark everyone's height on a wall.
- Sit together by the growth chart, and share ways you've noticed each other grow closer to Jesus. For example, maybe you've noticed that one of your kids has started putting other people first more.
